Abstract

The paper provides a case study on the history of social research on migration and integration in Switzerland in the 1960 and early 1970s. It takes a closer look at two landmark studies of Germanspeaking migration scholars in order to reconstruct the emergence of a new ‘sociologic’ of immigration and integration that has shaped not only the knowledge production but also the practices of civil and governmental actors and institutions in Switzerland since the 1960s. The intellectual pathways of Rudolf Braun and Hans-Joachim Hoffmann-Nowotny show that Swiss social research on immigration forms part of an international landscape of migration studies emerging within the postwar world order. The overall aim of the case study is to develop a new angle on the historical genealogy of “non-immigration immigration countries” like Switzerland.
